INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORM

The School of Advanced Manufacturing and Mechanical Engineering will offer up to 4 scholarships to assist Year 12 students pursuing a career in mechanical engineering.

Eligibility:

Scholarship applications are open to applicants who meet all of the following criteria:

- An Australian citizen or a permanent resident of Australia;
- Have completed their SACE Certificate (or interstate equivalent) with an entry TER of 90 or better;
- Have selected one of the following programs as preferences on their SATAC application form;
 - 434321 Bachelor of Engineering (Mechanical)
 - 434761 Bachelor of Engineering (Mechanical and Nanotechnology)
 - 434771 Bachelor of Engineering (Mechanical and Sustainable Systems)
 - 434781 Bachelor of Engineering (Mechanical and Mechatronic)
 - 434791 Bachelor of Engineering (Mechanical and Advanced Manufacturing)

Please note: UniSA reserves the right to not offer a scholarship if there are no suitable applicants

Retaining of Scholarship:

To continue to be eligible to receive the scholarship, applicants must:

- Maintain continued full-time enrolment of at least 8 courses during the scholarship term (based on Study Period 2 and Study Period 5 enrolments only) in one of the above-mentioned programs
- Maintain an overall Grade Point Average of 5.0 or higher during the first 1.5 years of the program for continual payment of scholarship payments.
- Not take leave from the program during first 1.5 years.

Value and Payments: \$2000 paid over 1.5 years to eligible students. Students who meet the entry and ongoing criteria for this scholarship will receive;

- \$500 payment after 31st March, upon confirmation of enrolment in 4 courses within the program.
- Further payments of 3x\$500 will be released to students upon completion of milestones. (Milestones: maintain Grade Point Average of 5.0 or higher after academic review for the periods: Year 1-Study Period 2 and Study Period 5; Year 2-Study Period 2)

Offers and Lodgement Details: Offers will be made on a competitive basis to applicants who have lodged a scholarship application with the School office by the closing date of 28 February. Submit completed applications (with a copy of year 12 subject results) to:
