HISTORY

Fred and Iris Ingham built this house at Magill in 1959. It was designed by architect John Tulloch and the builder was W.J. Moore & Son Pty Ltd.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Ingham collection is a complete set of documents telling the story of a suburban house in metropolitan Adelaide. The collection contains a booklet from W.J. Moore & Son Pty Ltd, c.1964, plans, sections and elevations, details, electrical installations plan, roof plan, joinery details, specifications, garden layout and plants list, miscellaneous receipts and product brochures, newspaper clipping featuring the Ingham house, real estate brochures for sale of house c.2007, photographs c.1961 and later of house and garden and a CD of an archival recording of the house.
