First Call for Papers

The 15th annual Australian Summer Accounting Symposium will be held at the University of Technology, Sydney on 2-3 February 2012. The 2012 Summer Accounting Symposium will comprise 2 key-note addresses and approximately 11 paper presentations. The key note speakers for 2012 will be Professor S.P. Kothari and Professor Joseph P. Weber, Sloan School of Management, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, USA. In 2011, the Symposium attracted leading accounting researchers from around the world, and presenters including faculty from leading institutions in North America, Europe and Asia. The School of Accounting at UTS is committed to ensuring that the Australian Summer Accounting Symposium continues as the premier event of its type in the Australasian region.

UTS Business School is located at the southern fringe of Sydney's central business district, adjacent to the Darling Harbour tourist precinct. It is close to a wide variety of hotel and apartment accommodation, as well as excellent public transport access to beaches and other tourist attractions.

Those interested in presenting a paper are encouraged to submit their work as soon as possible, but no later than 14 October 2011. Authors of selected papers will be advised no later than 18 November. Papers are invited in any area of accounting. Early submissions are encouraged.

The UTS School of Accounting will provide financial support for presenters of selected papers. This support will typically cover a return economy airfare from their home city to Sydney, Australia and three nights' accommodation.
