Postgraduate studies in Property at UniSA have been designed to provide professional education for those seeking a career in property as well as those currently in the industry looking to upgrade their skills and knowledge.

The program provides postgraduate level education in property research, valuation, asset management and land administration for graduates, and provides specialist education for the practicing property professional.

Why study at UniSA?

UniSA's postgraduate property program is the only postgraduate valuation accredited program run in South Australia that offers accreditation for membership to the Australian Property Institute and satisfies the SA Office of Consumer and Business Affairs education requirements for valuers.

Offered externally, the program is entirely flexible to meet the needs of those working full time or located away from campus.

UniSA has links with the Australian Property Institute who invite students to become student members. We also have formal links with the Australian Property Council of Australia and sponsor the Young Professionals program which provides our students with the opportunity to attend various networking functions.

Most of our students undertake industry-based projects providing for study and learning about a topical property issue with direct relevance to the modern workplace.

The Programs

The nested Property program provides multiple entry and exit points, offering flexibility to study.

Graduate Certificate in Property - The program is designed to provide supplementary coursework which will allow graduates of the Bachelor of Business (Property) to obtain registration in additional professional sequences or allow students with a property major to complete a professional sequence.

Graduate Diploma in Property - The program provides postgraduate level education in valuation, real estate, property management and land administration for graduates, and provides specialist education for the practising property professional.

Master of Property – The program provides postgraduate level education in property research, valuation, asset management and land administration for graduates, and provides specialist education for the practising property professional.

Many of UniSA's postgraduate students in Property are already working in the industry and are looking to obtain formal qualifications to enable them to practice in a specialised field, for example they may be working in a real estate agency and require a qualification to become a valuer.

Alternatively, the programs provide excellent career opportunities for those seeking a new transition into the property industry which includes opportunities across both private and public sectors.

For those with no prior experience, these qualifications prove invaluable as the first step into a new career in property.
