



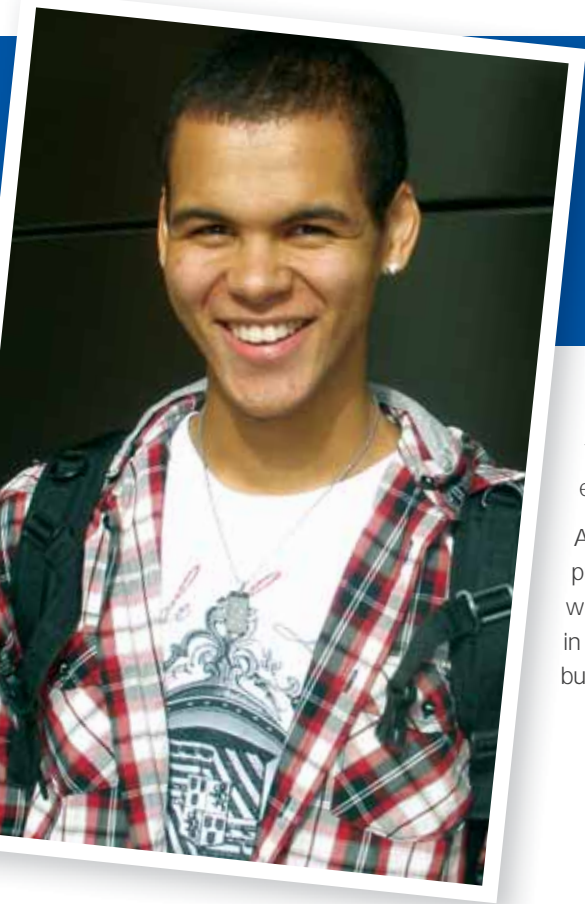

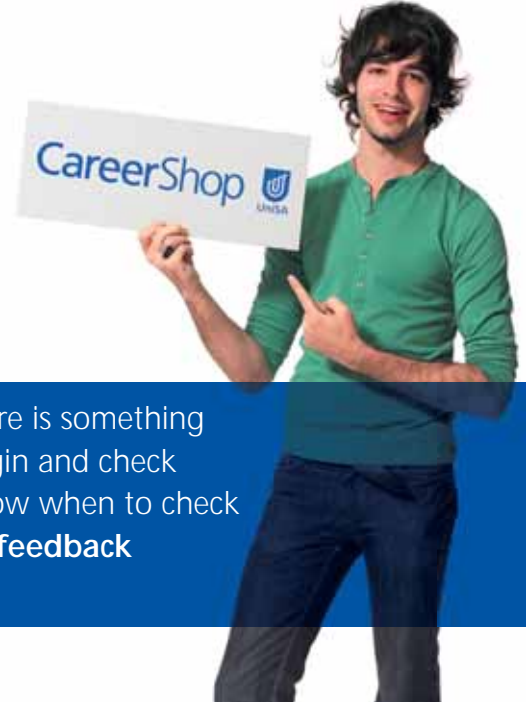

# Planning *AHEAD*

Choosing the subjects you take at school is an important step in planning your study and career path as these can impact which university degrees you are eligible for. Here's a quick run-down on how it all works, and you can head online to CareerShop for all the latest updates.

## Prerequisites

A subject you must take in Year 12 and pass with an achievement score of 10 or better to be considered for the UniSA program you have chosen. If a program has a prerequisite subject and you haven't completed it in year 12, you will not be offered a place in the program.

## Assumed knowledge

These subjects are not essential to gain entry into particular programs, but some prior experience in certain areas will help – like mathematical studies would make Pharmacy easier. Lecturers will assume you have some familiarity with their particular subject area.



## UniSA Advantage bonus points

UniSA offers you a helping hand to get into your chosen field through our unique bonus point scheme. **Achievement** bonus points reward your achievement (with a score of 10 or more) in selected Year 12 subjects. Also, Year 12 students who attend a school recognised by UniSA as disadvantaged, rural or isolated, automatically receive **Aspire** bonus points. If you're on a Student Card or Youth Allowance, but your school does not qualify for Aspire points, you may still be eligible and can apply online.

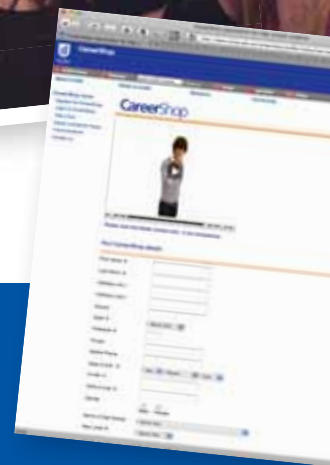
## Signing up
