Introduction

The following guidelines show how to install SPSS Statistics and AMOS as a customised “Site Licensed” installation for privately owned computers.

Note: This installation is not recommended for use on University owned (ie have a Blue Plate) computers on campus. University owned computers that are normally connected to the University network should have the “Network Licensed” installation which allows a licence to be borrowed if the system is taken off campus (up to 30 days).

IMPORTANT: SPSS products have strict licence conditions. Before using SPSS Statistics or AMOS you should read the licence conditions that are published on the web page:

Requirements

To install this software on your PC you'll need:

- SPSS Statistics and AMOS Work at Home Installation CDs
- An Internet connection
- SPSS Statistics 19 or AMOS 19 Authorization Code.

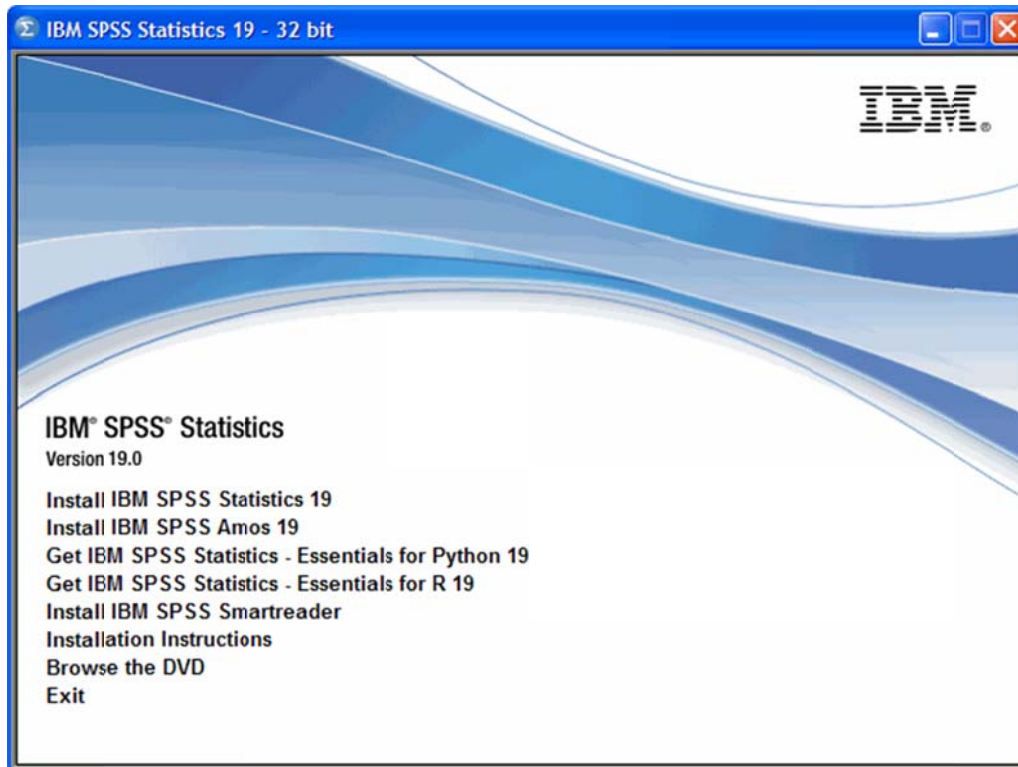
Note: The product Authorization Code can be found in the text file located in the directory <\\software\Licences\SPSS>. Contact the IT Help Desk if you do not have access. The Licence Authorization Code changes every year, you'll need to update this every year to continue using SPSS Statistics or AMOS (The licence expires on the 31st August each year).

SPSS Statistics Installation Instructions

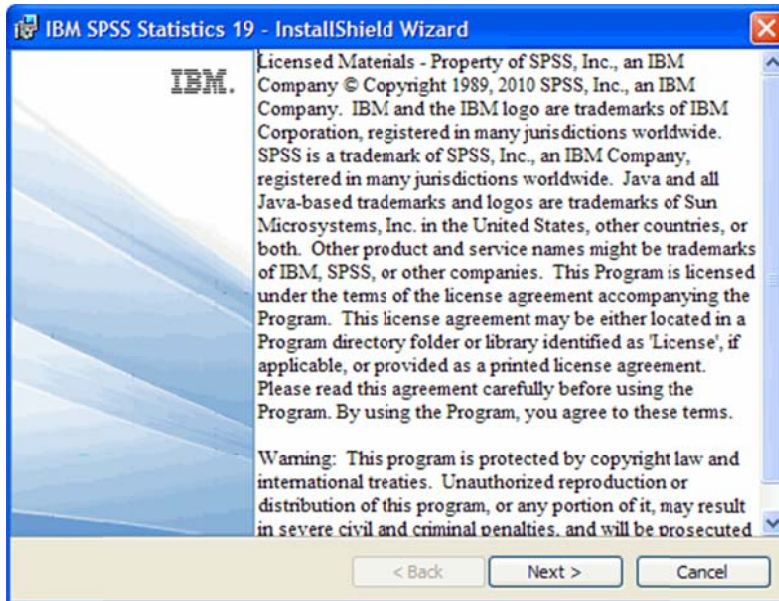
Uninstall all previous versions of SPSS or PASW Statistics before installing SPSS Statistics 19. As a precaution, ensure that any data is backed up before uninstalling software.

Insert the SPSS Statistics "Work at Home" installation CD in your computer's CD or DVD drive. You will be prompted with the following.

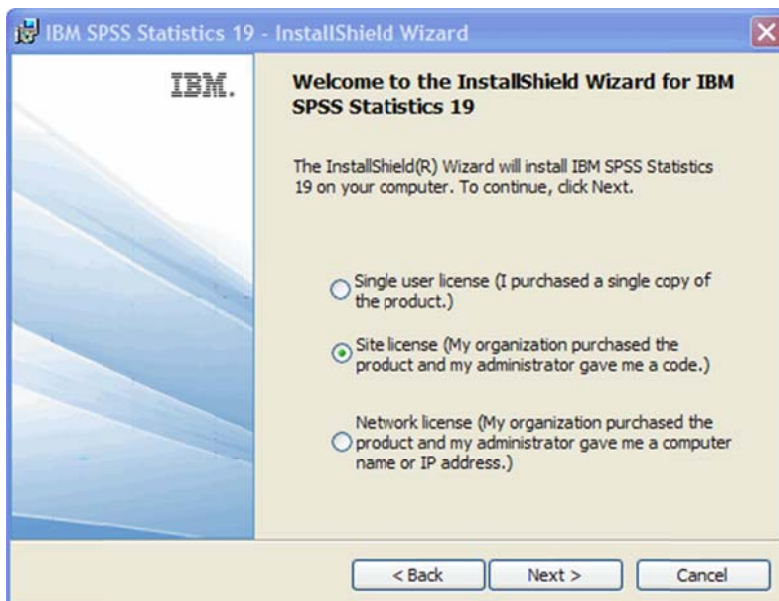
Select "**Install IBM Statistics 19**"



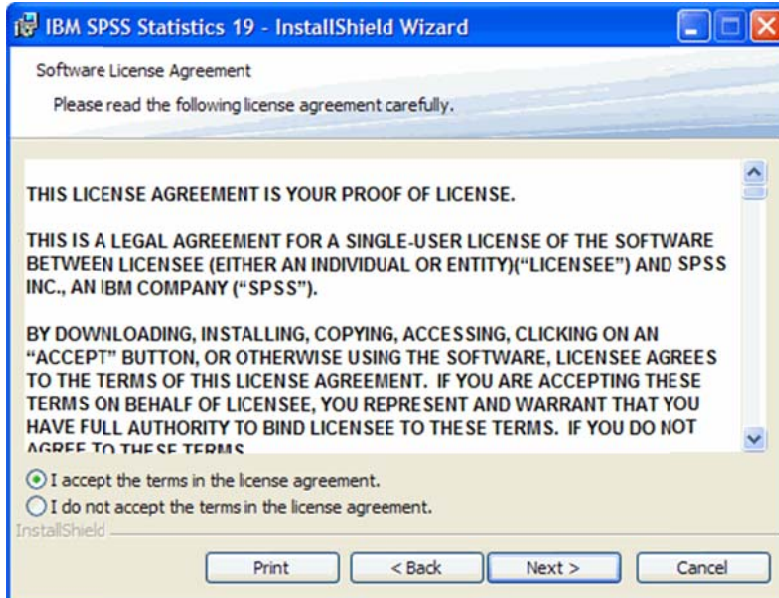
Click "**Next**".



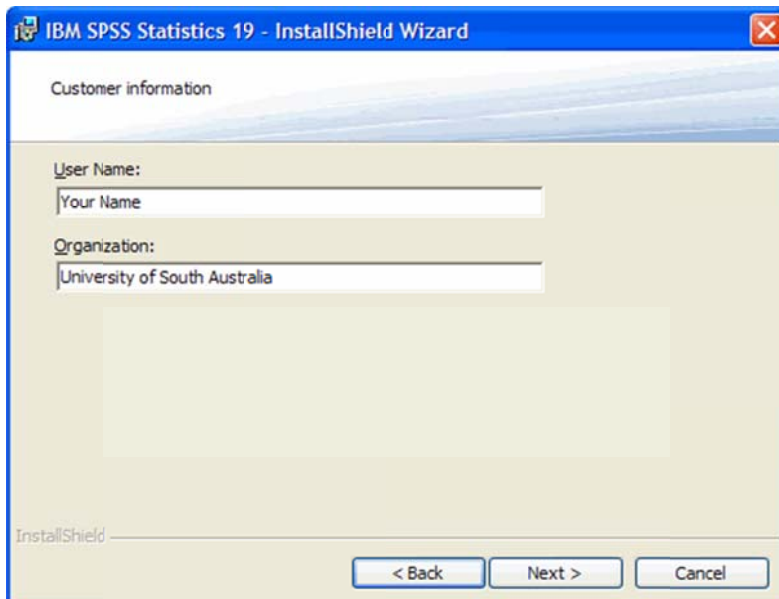
Select "**Site License**" when prompted and click "**Next**".



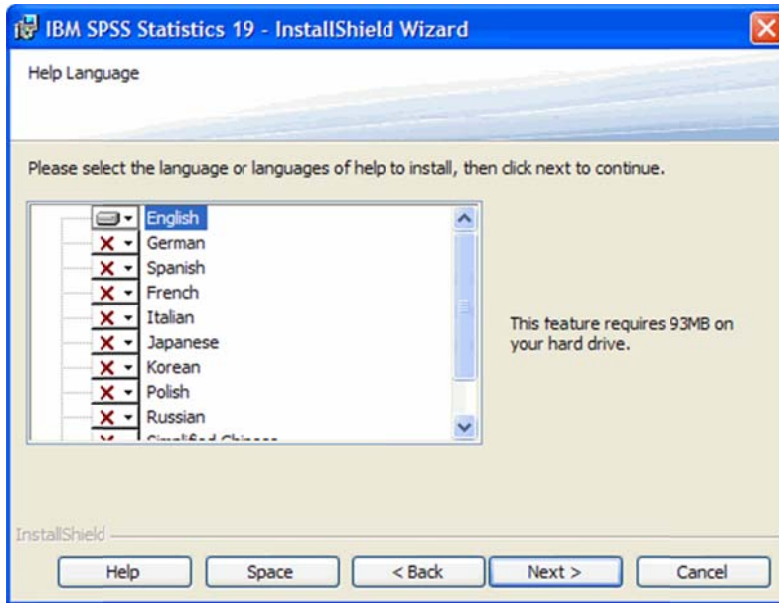
Read the terms of the licence agreement and select “*I accept the terms in the license agreement*” and click “*Next*”.



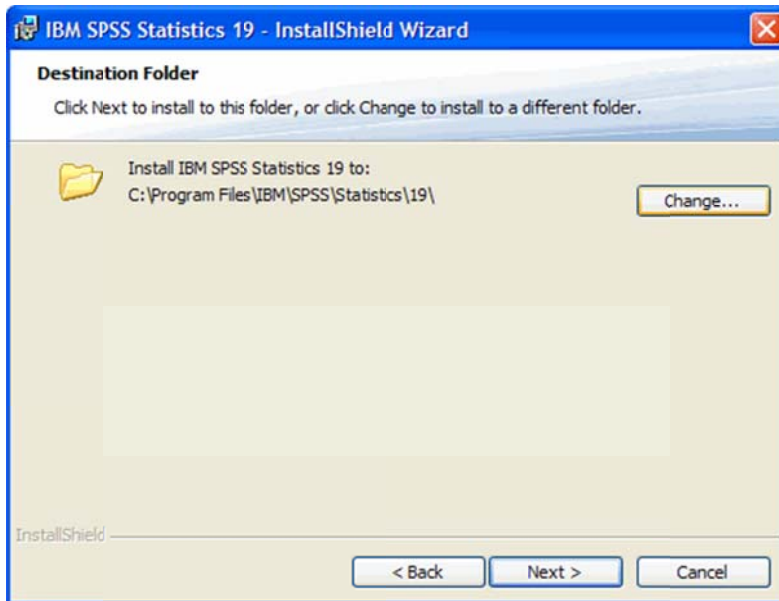
Enter your name and enter the “*University of South Australia*” in the appropriate fields.



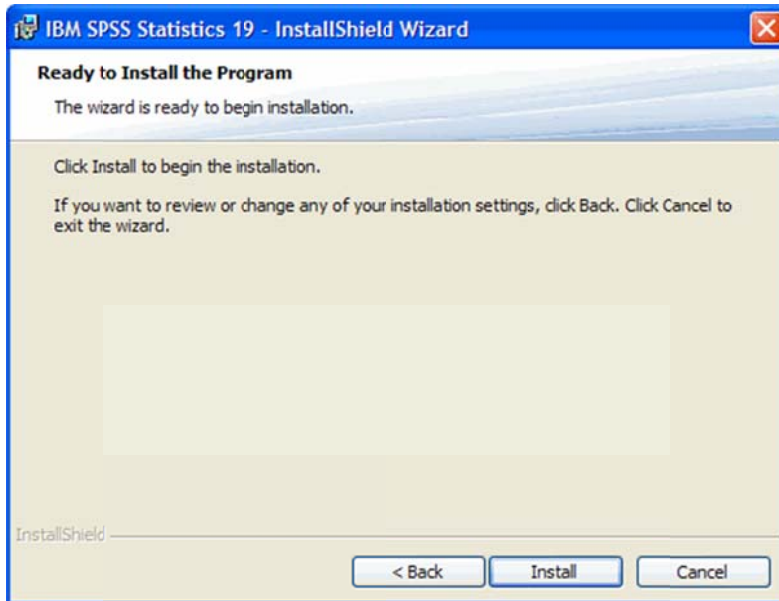
Change the language as required and click “**Next**”.



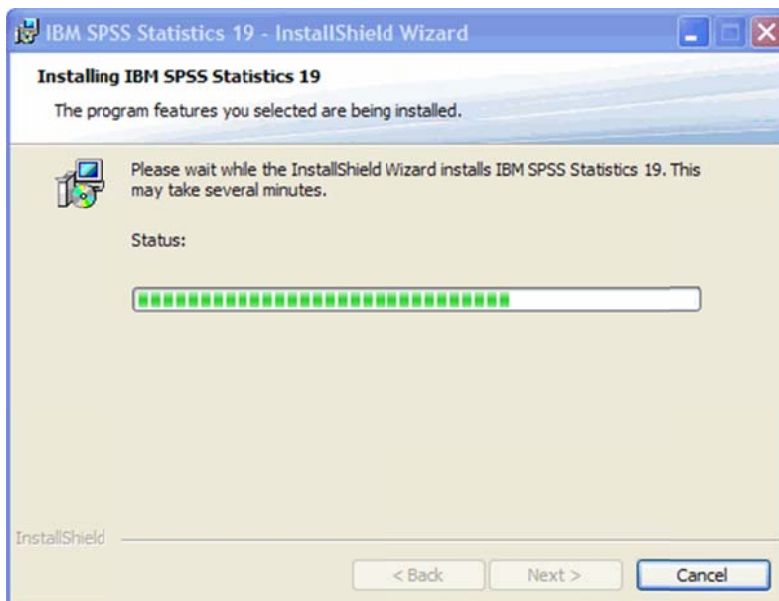
Accept or change the installation folder and click “**Next**”.



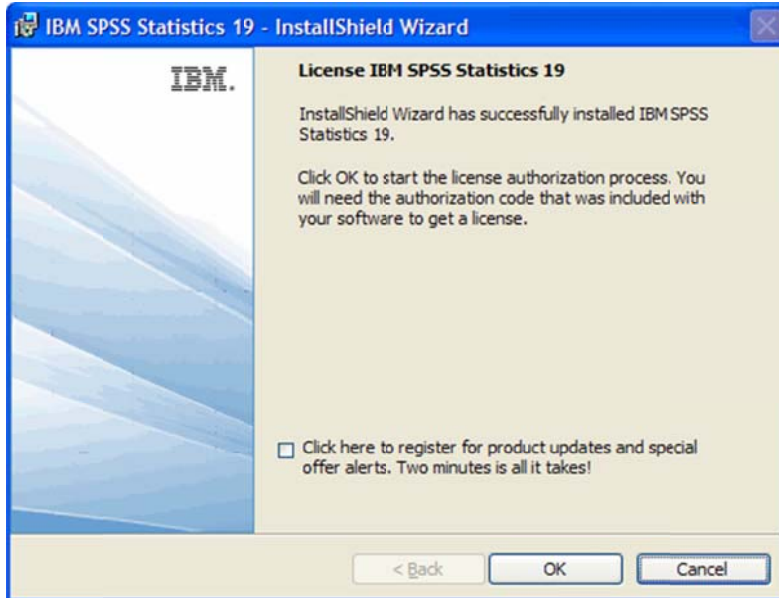
Click "**Install**" to install the application. It may take several minutes to install.



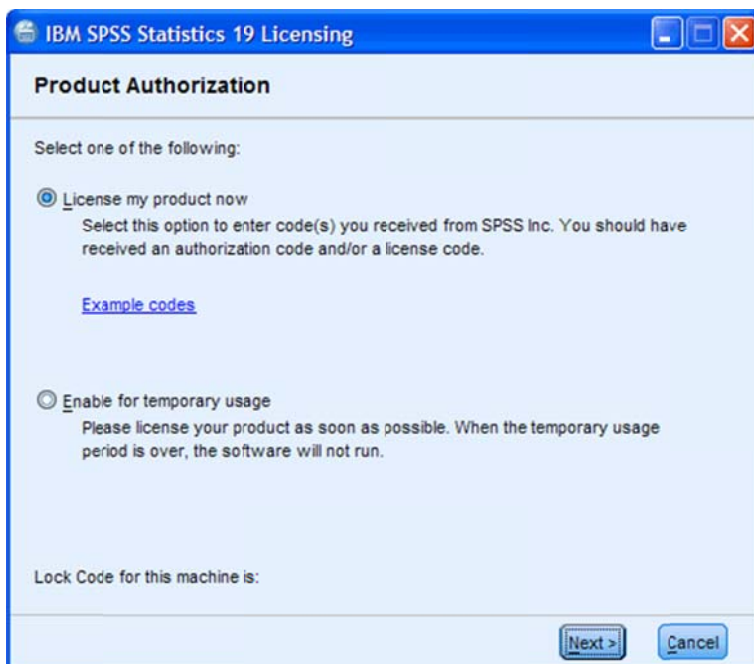
You will see something similar to the following while the application installs.



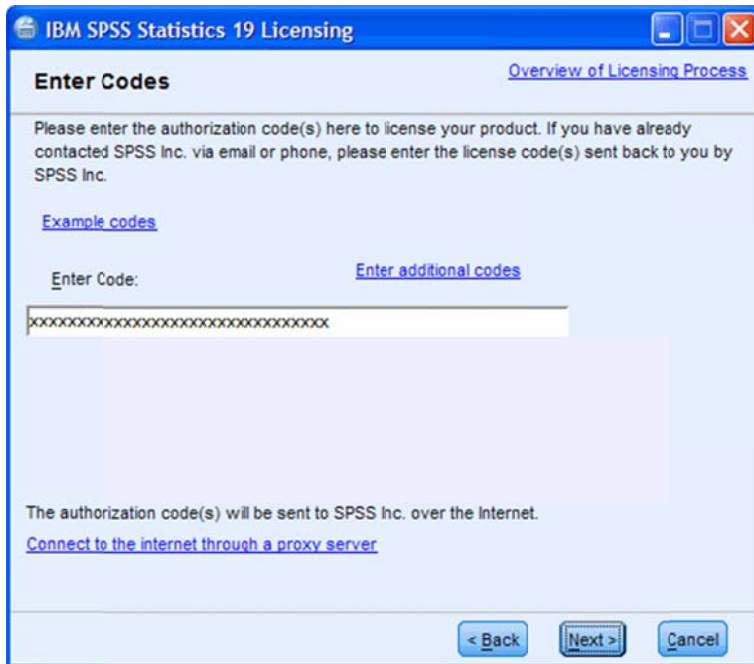
At the end of the installation a licence will need to be authorised. Uncheck the registration checkbox (optional) and select "**OK**" to continue.



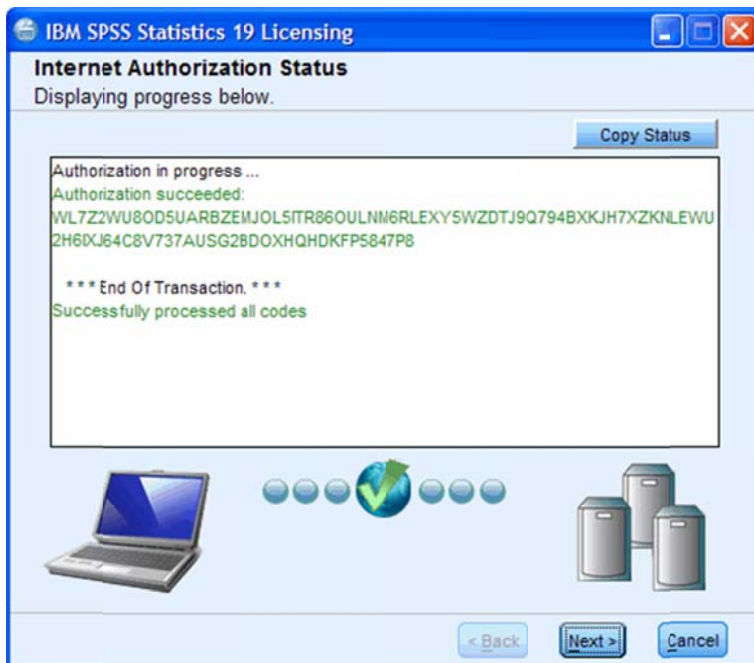
Select "**License my product now**" and click "**Next**".



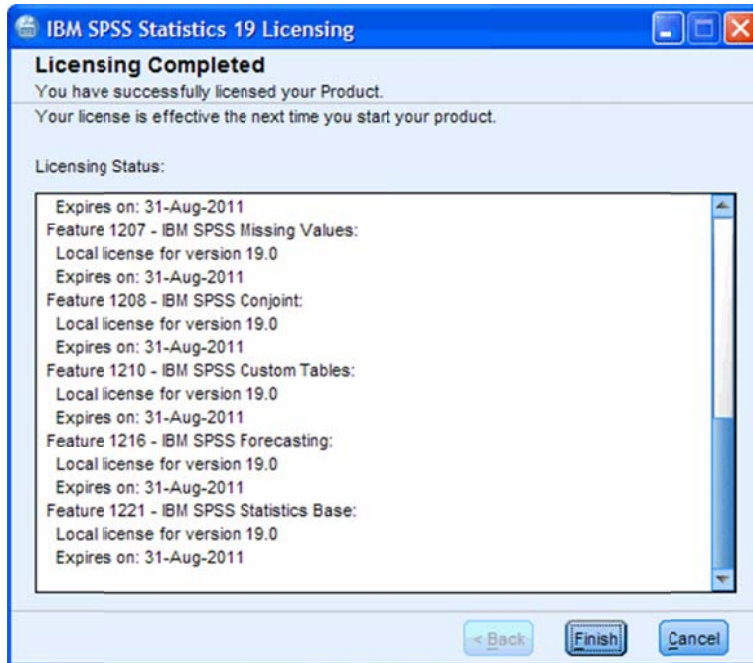
Enter the “**Authorization Code**” (Found in the text file located in the directory [\\software\Licences\SPSS](#)).



After the product has successfully authorized, select “**Next**”. If you do not have an internet connection or the authorization fails you will be presented with alternative methods to authorize PASW.



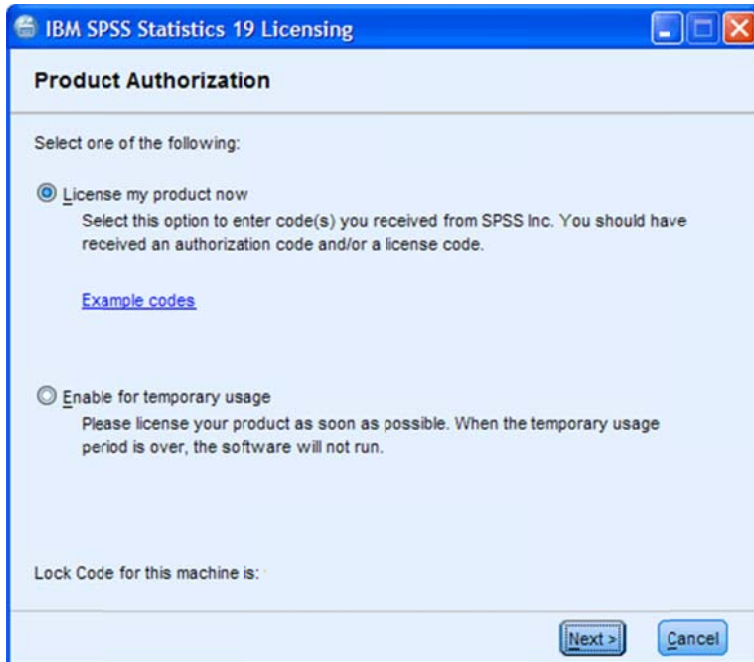
You should then see a summary of the licence. Click "**Finish**" to complete the Installation.



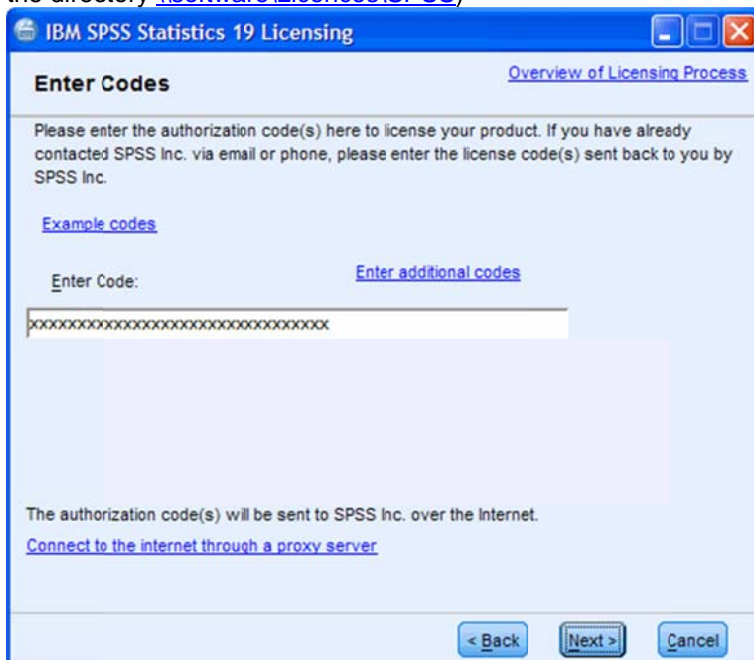
Renewing a SPSS Statistics Licence

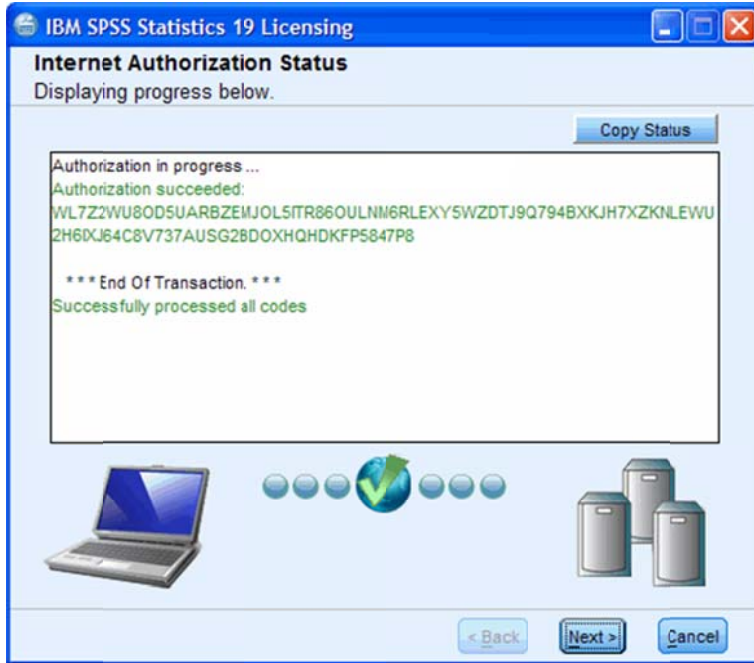
Select “**License my product now**” and click “**Next**”.



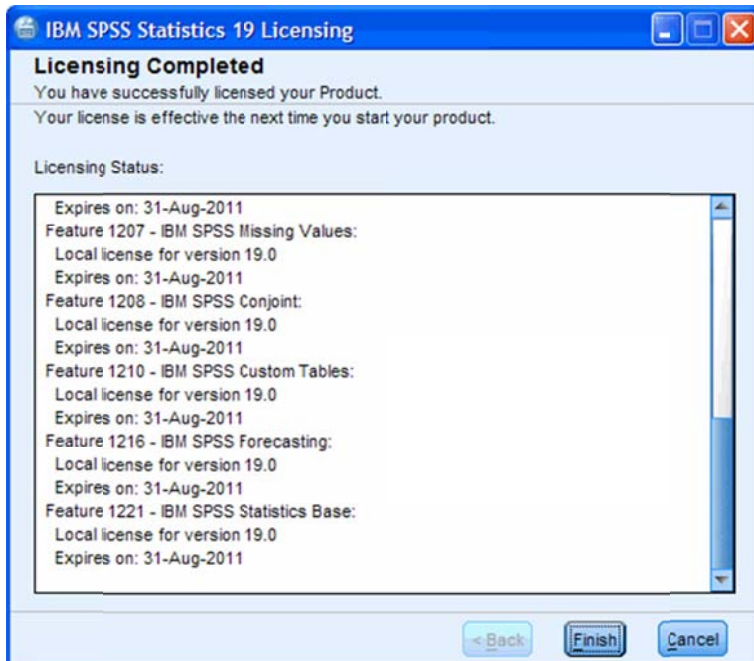
Enter the authorization code and select “**Next**”. Authorization code can be found in the text file located in the directory [\\software\Licences\SPSS](#)

You should then see a summary of the licence. Click “**Finish**” to complete the Installation.

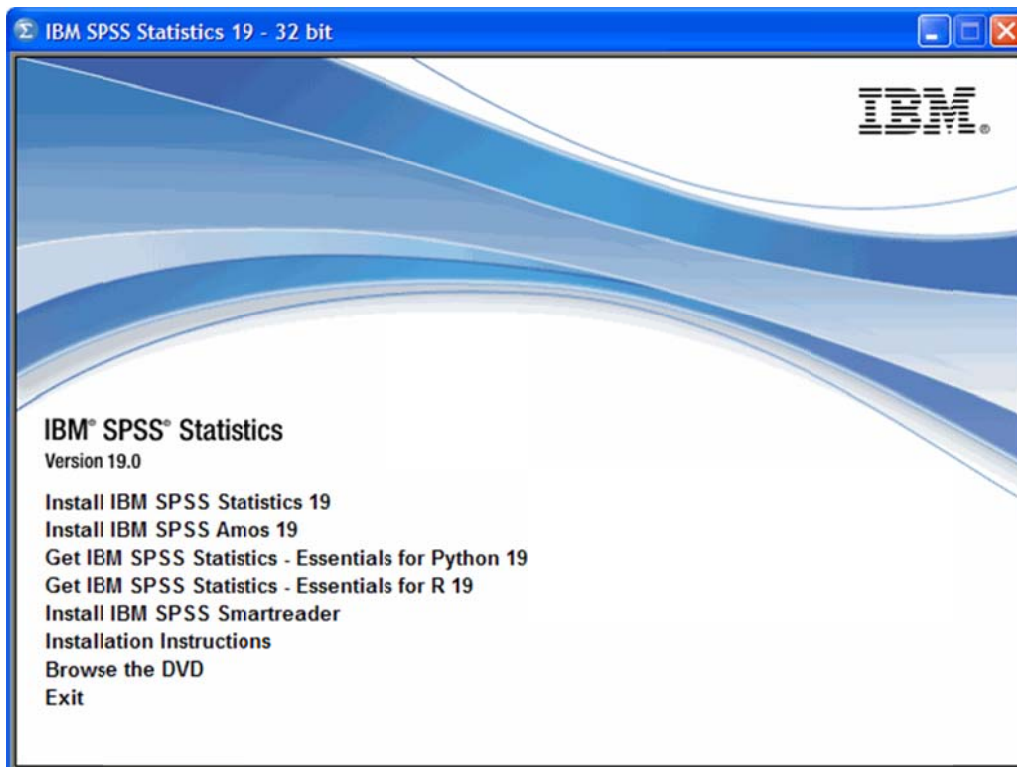


AMOS Installation Instructions

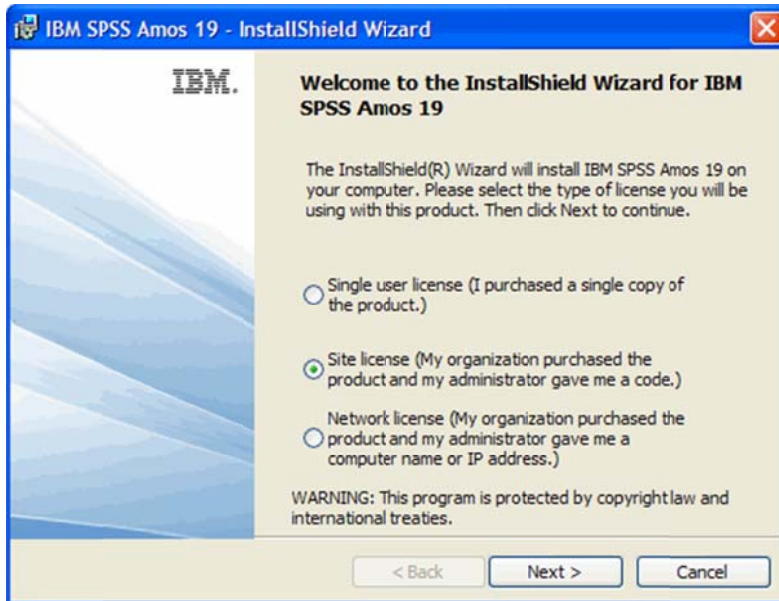
Uninstall all previous versions of AMOS before installing AMOS 19. As a precaution, ensure that any data is backed up before uninstalling software.

Insert the AMOS "**Work at Home**" installation CD in your computer's CD or DVD drive. You will be prompted with the following.

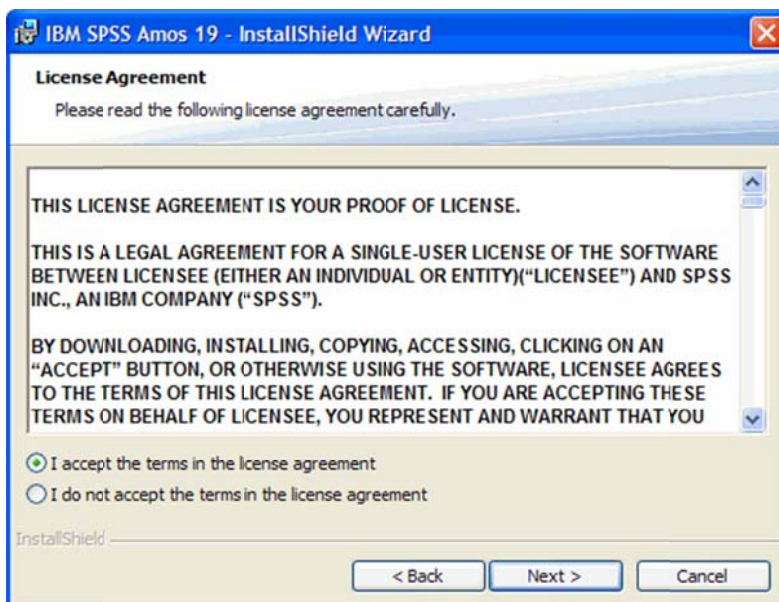
Select "**Install IBM SPSS AMOS 19**"




Select "**Site License**" when prompted and click "**Next**".



Read the terms of the licence agreement and select "**I accept the terms in the license agreement**" and click "**Next**".




Enter your name and enter the “*University of South Australia*” in the appropriate fields.



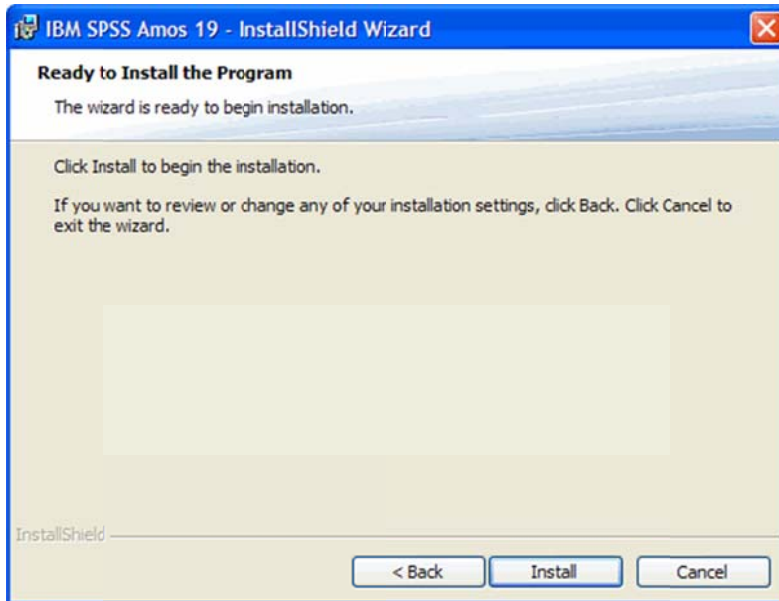

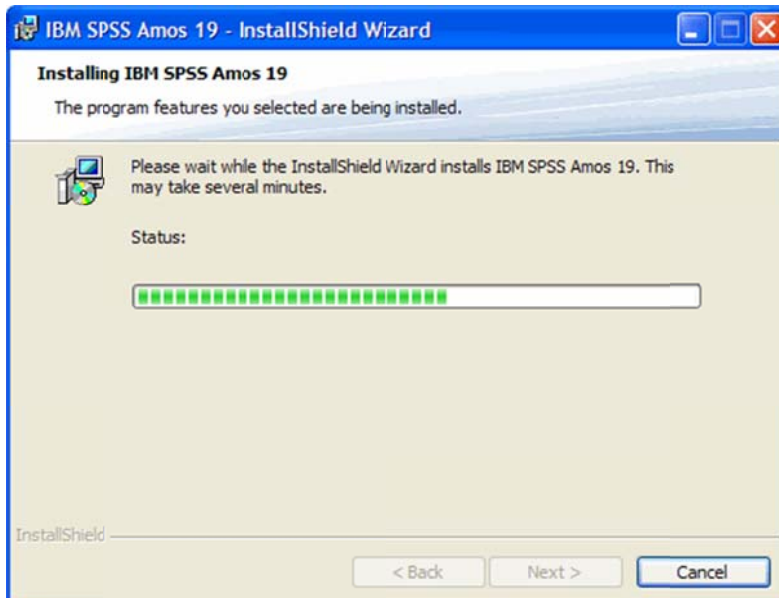

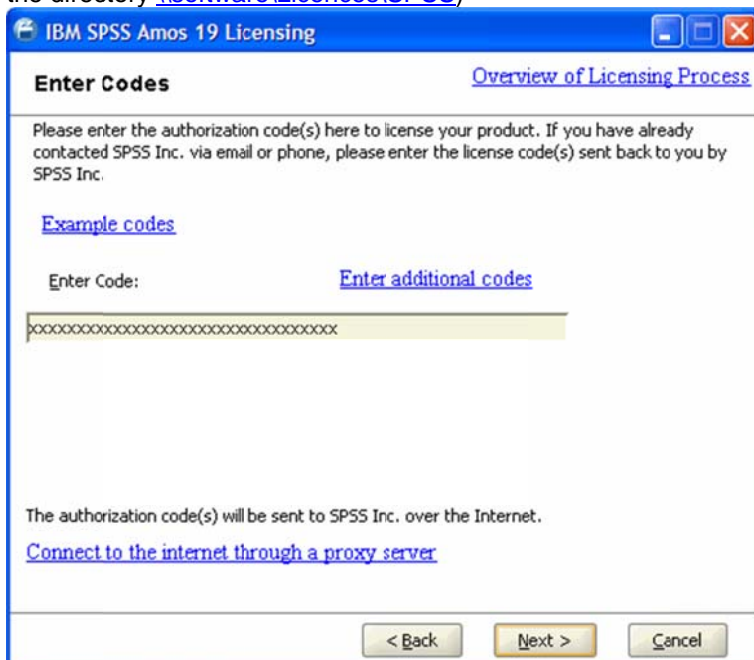
Renewing an AMOS Licence

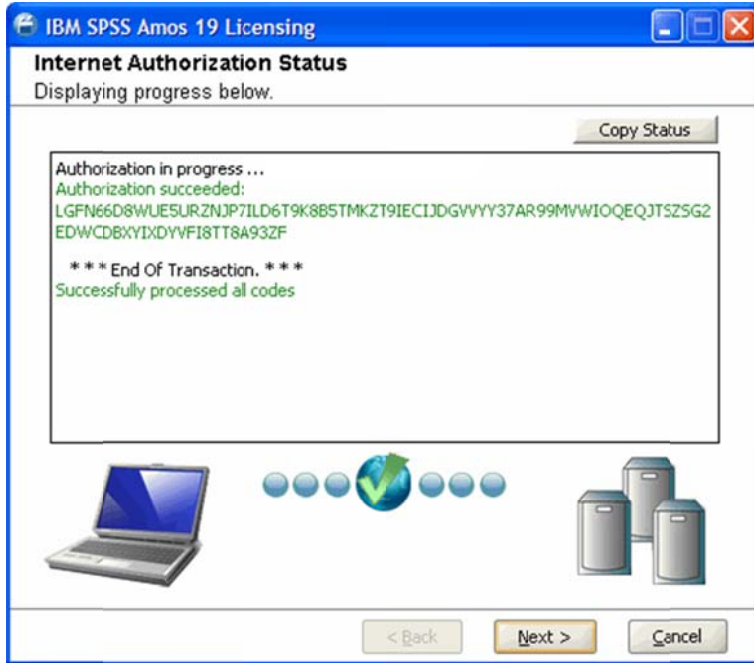
Select “**Licence my product now**” and click “**Next**”.
