2012 SHS-Space Program Scholarship

The scholarship benefits

Payment in full of the Program Fee of A\$10,900 for attendance at the Southern Hemisphere Summer Space Program from 9 January to 11 February 2012 which includes all tuition, accommodation and meals.

(CESA is making a contribution to funding this scholarship for a South Australian teacher in the Catholic system).

Who is eligible to apply?

Science and/or Mathematics teachers currently working in South Australian Catholic Schools:

- resident in Australia
- who have applied for enrolment in the Southern Hemisphere Summer Space Program and
- who have written authority to attend the program from their school Principal

Selection criteria

The CESA Selection Committee will select the scholarship winner taking into account:

- the applicant's commitment to Catholic education
- the applicant's teaching experience and motivation to deepen their understanding of space science
- the applicant's experience in or capacity to lead a team of professionals in the delivery of professional learning and services to teachers; and
- the applicant's financial circumstances

Documentation required

All applications will be judged on the basis of the information and supporting documents lodged as part of the on-line enrolment process at <http://shs-sp.isunet.edu/Apply>.

Authorisation for applicants to attend the Program must be given by the school Principal and forwarded to the Catholic Education SA, attention: Assistant Director, Learning and Student Wellbeing

(All eligible applicants, including those who have already enrolled, will be automatically considered unless an applicant specifically requests not to be considered by sending an email to inquiries.shs-sp@isunet.edu)

Conditions of award of scholarship

The scholarship winner will be requested by CESA to carry out the following tasks following the program:

1. Submit a written report at the conclusion of the SHS-SP describing the program and how they believe the SHS-SP will help them to further advance the teaching and learning of space science in their school.
2. Prepare and deliver several Professional Learning presentations to colleagues from Catholic schools describing the SHS-SP, their experiences from the program, and how their teaching of science has been enriched as a result of their attendance.

The winner of the scholarship will be notified no later than 15 December 2011.
