DEFINITIONS:Area + Catalogue Number

A 4-letter area code plus a 4-digit catalogue number make up the course code, e.g. **BIOL 1033**. You can search for courses using this code.

Class Number

Every class at UniSA has a unique number (e.g. **24813**). You use this number to enrol. Both the **enrolment class** and **related classes** have class numbers.

Enrolment Class

This can be a **lecture (LEC)**, **tutorial (TUT)**, **workshop (WSH)** or **practical (PRA)**, to name a few examples. It is the first class you must enter when you are enrolling.

Related Classes
(Non-Enrol Classes)

These are other required components of the course, and are in addition to the **enrolment class**. They can be one of the following class types - **lecture**, **tutorial**, **workshop** or **practical**, to name a few. In most cases you will have a choice (e.g. 1 tutorial to be chosen from 7). However, in some courses, once you select the **enrolment class** you are automatically enrolled (**auto-enrol**) in a related class (e.g. a particular tutorial or practical at a particular time).

NOTES:

1. The Principles of Project Management, Project Risk Management, Project Control Methods and Project Leaderships and Teams should be undertaken at the first opportunity as they are the four courses that teach project management fundamentals.
2. Students should enrol in all courses for both study periods (Study Period 2 & 5) when enrolments commence.
3. The table above shows the full list of courses to be taken by students undertaking a full-time load solely in both years of the program.
4. The program can be studied full-time or part-time.
5. Students must complete Project Management Minor Thesis 1 (BUSS 5295) prior to enrolling in Project Management Minor Thesis 2 (BUSS 5306). These courses form one project which requires an overall total of approximately 700 hours to complete.
6. International students are advised that this program is of 1.5 years full-time duration, not the 2 years formatted above. Please be aware that due to the structure of this program, you will be required to work on the Project Dissertation courses during the holiday periods. Please make an appointment to see your Program Director upon arrival to discuss your program of study.
7. Students may take Project Management Minor Thesis 1 (BUSS 5295) in either SP2 or SP5 depending on when they have commenced the program and then Project Management Minor Thesis 2 (BUSS 5306) should be taken in the following study period following completion of Project Management Minor Thesis 1
