### DEFINITIONS:

Area + Catalogue Number

A 4-letter area code plus a 4-digit catalogue number make up the course code, eg **BIOL 1033**. You can search for courses by using this code.

Class Number

Every class at UniSA has a unique number (eg **24813**). You use this number to enrol. Both the **enrolment class** and **related classes** have class numbers.

Enrolment Class

This can be a **lecture (LEC)**, **tutorial (TUT)**, **workshop (WSH)** or **practical (PRA)**, to name a few examples. It is the first class you must enter when you are enrolling.

Related Classes  
(Non-Enrol Classes)

These are other required components of the course, and are in addition to the **enrolment class**. They can be one of the following class types - **lecture**, **tutorial**, **workshop** or **practical**, to name a few. In most cases you will have a choice (eg 1 tutorial to be chosen from 7).

However, in some courses, once you select the **enrolment class** you are automatically enrolled (**auto-enrol**) in a related class (eg a particular tutorial or practical at a particular time). The class number will be listed in the Auto-enrol column.

# INSTRUCTIONS

## CLASSES

1. The classes listed below are the best options for your program.
2. View the course homepage by clicking on the links below. Click on the Class Timetable link on the course homepage to view the day and time of the classes listed for the course.
3. Read the notes listed against the classes on the timetable. If the note states that the class is allocated to a degree other than IBPP then **do not** select the class for enrolment in the first instance.

## ENROLMENT

1. Once you are ready to enrol into your courses ensure that you have selected the correct Study Period.
2. Once you have selected a course, start enrolling with the enrolment class first and then select a related class as required.
3. Students who are enrolling over 2 years of study (i.e. 2 courses from 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2 courses from 2<sup>nd</sup> year) **will** encounter enrolment clashes, as the timetables are designed to be clash-free over one year of study. If this occurs you will need to complete an Override Form to inform the school timetabler of your problem.
4. If classes become full you will need to complete an Override Form to inform the school timetabler of your problem.
5. Note that completing an Override Form **does not** mean that you will definitely be granted your request. Ensure that you provide as much detail as possible in the Override Form.
6. **Note you will need to enrol in the whole year that is all SP2 and SP5 courses.**
7. See below for your elective choice for each study period. **If you want to enrol in an elective that is not part of your stream you will need to contact the Program Director.**
