

## Follow the 7 steps to apply

Follow 7 easy steps to maximise the success of your application. Track your progress by ticking off the steps as you go in this document. Refer to the [Research degrees website](#) for full information.

### 1 Check that you are eligible

- [English language proficiency](#) - for international applicants.
- [Entry requirements](#) - normally a four-year undergraduate degree with high grades is the minimum. [Are you eligible? View the pathways](#)
- [Admission criteria](#) - for a Doctor of Philosophy, Masters by Research and Professional Doctorate

### 2 Find a research degree program

You will need to provide information about your proposed program of study.

### 3 Find a supervisor

You will need to provide the name of your proposed supervisor at UniSA.

### 4 Find a scholarship

You will need to provide information about any scholarships you may wish to apply for.

### 5 Organise supporting statements

- Contact *two* academic referees and ask them to complete the [Academic Referees Report](#)

### 6 Complete the online application form

You will need to provide details about:

- your proposed research, including the proposed thesis title
- any awards or prizes you've received
- any professional experience
- any publications you have authored or co-authored

### 7 Provide relevant documentation

You will need to send copies of the following information:

- transcripts of undergraduate, honours and postgraduate courses undertaken (even if not completed)
- certification of English language proficiency (if relevant)
- passport details (if you are an international applicant)
