The Country Education Foundation of Australia (CEFA) is a national not for profit organisation that helps rural communities establish local education foundations. These local education foundations are members of CEFA and raise funds to provide financial assistance to local youth to assist them achieve their post high school education and vocation goals. To apply for financial assistance applicants must live or attend high school in a community that has a local education foundation. The University of South Australia is committed to ensuring as many rural youth as possible have the opportunity of a tertiary education. As part of this commitment, in 2007 University of South Australia became a CEFA Education Partner.

This partnership means that CEFA recipients (someone who has received financial assistance from a CEFA education foundation community) who attend the University of South Australia as a full time undergraduate student will receive additional financial assistance from the University, with preference given to first year students. The value of this grant is determined by how many students CEFA has attending University of South Australia in any one year. Typically grants can be worth between \$250 and \$2,000.
